Staffing: 1 member of staff left, 2 new members of staff joined Jackie and Amelia.

Christmas rota complete and Christmas cocktails to be advertised, mulled wine, mince pies available for festive events.

Entertainment on NYE changed from advertised band.

World Cup fixtures to be advertised, drinks promotion to be considered (Carling).

Prices need to increase, there has been on average over the last 3 months a 6% increase on all items also many barrels increasing by £11 each. Suggested by stock taker 20p price increase, members Carling would become £3.65 and ales £3.40. This is still significantly cheaper than main pubs. Non-members prices £4.15 and ales £3.90 - Committee discussed about the increase. Vote for when the increase should occur December 1st 2022 or January 1st 2023. Vote 4 for, 2 against. Prices will increase from December 1st 2022.
